

FACE SEAL INSPECTION GUIDE

Does the cylinder valve look like this?






This is a 20 lb cylinder equipped with an OPD valve and a face seal that is in good

YES? THEN YOU NEED TO INSPECT THE FACE SEAL.

These are some examples of damage. If the face seal doesn't look like the one above, or if you are concerned:

DO NOT FILL THE CYLINDER.

Advise the cylinder owner that the cylinder must be removed from service.
